

Energising regional communities

Our involvement in regional communities goes beyond providing power and building new infrastructure. We're committed to growing regional WA by supporting our local communities and their great initiatives through our Community Partnerships Program.



Funding available between

\$1,000 and \$50,000

If you're making a difference in your community, you can apply for a community partnership.

\$1,000 to \$10,000

Must include one of our service areas.

\$10,001 to \$50,000

Must include at least two of our service areas.

We have a preference to not be the sole funder of your initiative so cash contributions from your organisation or another funder is highly recommended.

Is your organisation eligible?

If you're a not for profit organisation or a local government authority we can support your organisation with initiatives such as:

- Events
- · Equipment or fit out
- · Short term projects.

Our guiding principles

We apply our guiding principles to everything we do, the way we work and the way we engage. Your initiative needs to be aligned to at least one of our four guiding principles:

- Community Involvement listening, creating and delivering together
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commitment – positive impact on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander customers, suppliers, employees and communities
- Cleaner, Greener improving our shared environment
- Regions First preference towards local people, goods and services.

What we can support:

- Initiatives/events that are regionally based in Horizon Power's service area
- Initiatives/events that will contribute
 to the community and have clear
 community outcomes
- Initiatives/events that are aligned to at least one of Horizon Power's guiding principles
- Events that are accessible for all and are free or very low cost to attend
- Equipment/fit out for organisations delivering projects in the regions
- Projects that are time limited (not ongoing)
- Activities that support good health and well-being in communities.

What we can't support:

- Organisations associated with or promoting gambling, alcohol, smoking or drug use
- · Individuals
- Commercial activities
- Federal or State Government led projects
- · Individual sporting teams
- · Political activities
- · Schools
- · Religious activities
- Initiatives based outside of Horizon
 Power's service area
- Ongoing operational costs
- Community fundraising e.g. fetes, corporate golf days or charity dinners
- Prizes or trophies for sporting events
- Cash prizes.
